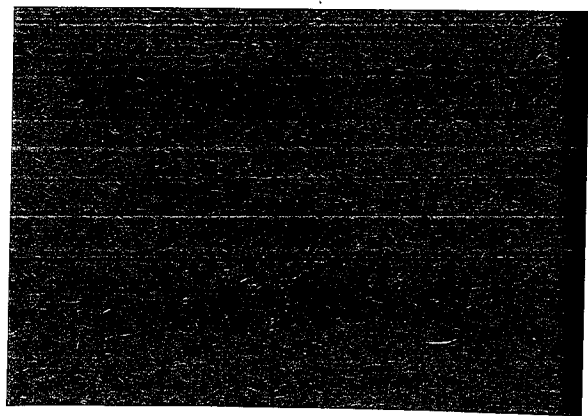

Application for Designation of a Neighbourhood Area

The Bayswater Residents' Association would like to apply for the designation of its recognised area as a Neighbourhood Area under the provisions of the Localism Act.

A map is attached outlining the area which we would like to be designated. This map was originally produced by Westminster City Council and shows the area for which the Bayswater Residents' Association has responsibility as an Amenity Society recognised by the City Council. Its borders are the same, where adjacent to them, as of our neighbouring recognised Amenity Societies, namely SEBRA and the Westbourne Neighbourhood Association.

The Bayswater Residents' Association was founded in 1974 and since the early Eighties has been the body statutorily consulted by the City Council on all planning applications for sites within its area.

Our membership covers all parts of the area. At our recent AGM we amended our constitution and widened its objectives to encourage and enable all persons living or working in the area including businesses to take up membership.

This letter is copied to the Councillors of the Bayswater and Lancaster Gate Wards and the two Amenity Societies referred to above.
