

Westminster City Council Core Strategy – Adoption Statement

This Adoption Statement gives notice that Westminster City Council resolved to adopt its Core Strategy on the 26 January 2011. The Core Strategy is the principal document in the Local Development Framework and provides the vision, objectives and spatial policies to guide development in the Borough over the next fifteen to twenty years.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power and / or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made within six weeks from the date of adoption of the Core Strategy – by **9 March 2011**.

The Core Strategy, Proposals Map, the Inspector's Report, this Adoption Statement and the Sustainability Appraisal Report are available for public inspection on the Council's website at www.westminster.gov.uk/services/environment/planning/ldf/corestrategy/.
