### Technical Note: UDP Saved Policies – Appendices

Where a policy has been saved beyond 24 January 2010, as set out in the Secretary of States's Direction of 14 January 2010, any UDP appendices or tables referenced in that policy by virtue of their association with the policy remain extant. This is because the Secretary of State cannot retain

or delete appendices in its saved policy Direction. However, we had recommended the deletion of the following appendices for the reasons given, therefore caution should be exercised in applying these for development management purposes:

3.1	Housing sites of less than 50 units identified by the City Council where on-site affordable housing has been required	These sites have largely been implemented.
3.2	Examples of financial contributions to affordable housing	Figures superseded by annual reviews published on the internet.
7.4	Health and Environmental Status of Shopping Areas in Westminster	This is out of date. More up to date health checks would be used as a material consideration in the determination of a planning application where necessary.
