This policy has been developed by all the relevant council services including Licensing, Planning and Highways.

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Licensing Sub-Committee – Thursday 25th October 2012

Patty & Bun, 54 James Street, W1 (Marylebone High Street / not in stress area) –
Granted under Delegated Authority prior to the hearing.

Costa Dorada, 47-55 Hanway Street, W1 (West End Ward / West End Stress Area) –
Application for a review of the premises licence. The application was submitted by Premises Management – Environmental Health under the Prevention of Crime and Disorder licensing objective. The Licensing Enforcement Team had been made aware some months ago that there was a change of ownership in those operating the premises. After a number of communications, the Enforcement Team became very concerned at the lack of management at the premises and the regular breach of conditions by the Licensee, especially in relation to alcohol not being consumed ancillary to a meal at the restaurant and touting. On 11th October, however, a transfer application was submitted so that a previous Designated Premises Supervisor at the premises returned to the role. The inspectors were of the view that there had not been any issues when she had previously been the DPS. The Sub-Committee considered it appropriate to add 3 conditions suggested by the applicant including the restaurant model condition, that the supply of alcohol would be by waiter or waitress service only and that a log would be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. A supper hours condition was deleted in order to remove the ambiguity caused by the sentence that the ‘sale of alcohol must be ancillary to the use of the premises for music and dancing and substantial refreshment’ at the restaurant. A condition suggested by the Licensee was attached to the licence that alcohol could be sold and consumed prior to a meal by up to a maximum of 20 people in the designated area.

The Conran Shop, 55 Marylebone High Street, W1 (Marylebone High Street / not in stress area) – The premises operates as a retail shop selling high end furniture, home wares and gifts. The application specified that the alcohol for consumption off the premises would be mainly part of food/gift hampers. The Sub-Committee heard from a local resident that there were issues with rubbish being left out by The Conran Shop on Devonshire Place Mews and with lorries, responsible for deliveries, blocking this area. The local resident also stated that he had experienced noise nuisance from a party at the premises. The Sub-Committee advised the local resident to contact the Noise Team and/or the Street Management Service and requested that he be provided with details of the Warden for Marylebone High Street. The Sub-Committee granted the application for off-sales Monday to Saturday 09:00 to 21:00 hours and Sunday 09:00 to 19:00 hours, considering that the

proposed conditions which had been acceptable to Environmental Health and the Metropolitan Police were comprehensive and would promote the licensing objectives. If the conditions were not complied with, local residents would have the option to submit a review application.

The Net Bar, 36-38 Hanway Street, W1 (West End Ward / West End Stress Area) -
Application for a review of the premises licence. The application was submitted by The Licensing Authority under the Prevention of Crime and Disorder licensing objective. The Sub-Committee was informed that a number of breaches of the licence had been found by Licensing Inspectors since 2006, including the absence of a registered SIA door supervisor at the nightclub, CCTV not being in full working order, the Rules of Management being breached and the unavailability of substantial food. It was made clear that there was little confidence in the Designated Premises Supervisor. The Licensee's Representative stated that it was accepted that the lack of a response to the concerns raised by the Licensing Inspectors was unacceptable and that the DPS would be replaced. The SIA door staff had already been changed, the CCTV had been updated, a report with detailed recommendations had been submitted by a consultant working with the premises and an architect was advising on a change to the layout which would place more emphasis on food. The Sub-Committee decided to remove the DPS and attached conditions, including that the CCTV condition would be updated, that there would be a personal licence holder at the premises at all times it was operating, that a menu would be prominently displayed at the bar and at all tables throughout the premises and that a record of staff training would be kept. Environmental Health would examine the premises to ensure that aspects such as the Rules of Management conditions were complied with.
