

Active Westminster Awards 2011

Refer to our award entry criteria below to help you complete your ActiveWestminster Awards nomination form.



Active Resident award

Criteria: This category is for Westminster residents who have made a difference to their own or other peoples' lives through sport or physical activity. Nominate someone who you think has made a particular impact on sport, or difference to people's lives this year. In your nomination, please include:

- Examples of their commitment to sport.
- What impact they have had and why they have made a difference.

Active Volunteer award

Criteria: This category is open to residents who give up their free time to make a difference to sport and leisure in Westminster. In your nomination, please include some or all of the following:

- How they have encouraged more people to take part in sport including low participation and hard to reach groups.
- How have they used innovative ideas to promote, develop or enhance their role.
- How they are committed to their own personal development.
- Details of what makes them stand out.
- Describe why you think they are a positive role model.

Champion of the Future award

Criteria: Open to Westminster Champions of the Future and other talented athletes. Please include details of success against adversity.

Coach or Community Exercise Instructor award

This category is for community coaches or exercise instructors who have made a difference to other peoples' lives through sport or physical activity. In your nomination, please include some or all of the following:

- How the person has encouraged more people to take part in or succeed in sport or physical activity.
- How they have increased opportunities for people of all ages.
- How the club has encouraged people, including low participation and hard to reach groups, to take part in sport or physical activity.
- Details of innovative ideas or professional development.
- What sets them apart from other coaches/instructors?
- What makes them a role model?

Active Club award

Criteria: This award recognises the most outstanding community sports club of the year. It must be an Active Westminster accredited club (please check with your local club if you are not sure). In your nomination, please include some or all of the following:

- How the club has encouraged people, including low participation and hard to reach groups, to take part in sport or physical activity.
- How it has helped people to improve their sporting skills.
- Details of innovation in promoting or enhancing its programme or facilities.
- Details of any partnership working such as links with local schools.
- What sets it apart from/makes it a role model for other clubs.
- Is it accessible to all users and are staff trained in accessibility?

Active Place award

Criteria: This award covers public and private facilities including but not limited to sports, facilities, community halls, parks and open spaces, sports pitches. In your nomination, please demonstrate innovation through re-development, and the measurable and positive impact it has on local residents active wellbeing.

Active School award

Criteria: Open to primary, secondary and special schools as well as colleges of further education in Westminster. The category will award the school that has made the biggest impact on encouraging healthy and active lifestyles for Westminster's young people. In your nomination, please include some or all of the following:

- Why the project was needed.
- The impact of the project.
- How it has contributed to health and achievement for students as part of the government's Healthy Schools programme.

Physical Activity, Health and Wellbeing award

Criteria: This category awards an innovative physical activity project or programme that has improved lives. In your nomination, please include some or all of the following:

- The reason for the project.
- Details of partnership working.
- Details of any consultation undertaken.
- How it was funded.
- The impact it had on the target audience.
- What makes it unique.

Inclusive and Active award

Criteria: Awards a project or programme that has been particularly beneficial in increasing access to those with disabilities and has encouraged equal access to sport and leisure to everybody in Westminster.

In your nomination, please include some or all of the following:

- How the project increased participation levels amongst disabled people.
- How the project increased equal access to sport and leisure.

Outstanding Contribution to Sport in Westminster

Criteria: This category awards a special person, group or organisation that excels and stands out as making an outstanding contribution to high quality sport, fitness, and leisure activities in Westminster. In your nomination, please include:

- Examples of their commitment to sport.
- What impact they have had.

Active Participant or Coach at the London Youth Games

Criteria: Awards the most outstanding individuals at this year's London Youth Games. In your nomination, please include some or all of the following:

- How the coach or team has demonstrated commitment above and beyond what is expected.
- Improvement in results from the previous year.

Your nominations will be considered by an independent judging panel and the winners will be announced online and at the Active Awards in November.
